

Kickapoo Rail Trail Construction Open House

The Kickapoo Rail Trail will be a multi-use trail open to the public for hiking, biking, and other non-motorized use and will stretch 24.5 miles from Kickapoo State Park to Urbana, Illinois. **Phase One construction of the Vermilion County portion is set to begin this summer and will extend from Gray's Siding Road to the west side of Oakwood.**

While the KRT Construction Open House is open for anyone to attend, it is intended for those living along or adjacent to the Phase One portion of the bike path as well as members of the Oakwood village and Gray's Siding community. The Construction Open House is an opportunity to learn information on all aspects of KRT development. Vermilion County Conservation District staff and volunteers will man stations to provide updates and answer questions about natural resources, funding, marketing, educational components, construction, and maintenance of the trail.
