The ride will begin and end at Kickapoo State Park, near Oakwood, IL .
(large pavilion near the cemetery)

There will be a 62 mile (metric century) and a 32 mile loop.

Early registration will be \$35 until May 12th and those registrants will receive a free KRT tee shirt. Cost for those who register after May 12th and on the day of event will also be \$35 but they will not receive a complimentary tee shirt. There will be KRT tee shirts and other merchandise available for sale on the day of event.

Registration will begin at 7:00 AM. Riders may start at 7:30 AM. Those who wish to ride the 62 mile route need to begin no later than 8:30 AM. All riders must start by 10:00 AM.

A lunch will be provided for all cyclists upon completion of the ride.

All routes will have SAG support and there will be rest stops available with snacks and drinks. Rest stops and SAG support will end at 2:30 PM

The route is an open road course and riders must obey all the rules of the road.

Helmets are required by all riders. Safety first!

All proceeds will benefit the Kickapoo Rail Trail.

What is the KRT ?

Upon completion, the Kickapoo Rail Trail will be a 24.5 mile trail that follows the former Conrail railroad from East Urbana to Kickapoo State Park outside of Danville, IL. It will pass through the communities of Mayview, St. Joseph, Ogden, Fithian, and Oakwood. The trail is designed for pedestrians and bicyclists to traverse some of the most diverse ecosystems in this part of the state, including woodland, prairie, and wetland.

The first segment of the Kickapoo Rail Trail stretching 6.7 miles from Urbana to St. Joseph is now open! The trail is open to the public for hiking, biking, and other non-motorized uses. It is projected that Vermilion County will break ground on the eastern end of the trail sometime in mid 2018.
