## VCCD Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions

# How do I register?

Mail or drop off the registration form found at https://vccd.org/summer-programs/, or at the Kennekuk and Forest Glen offices. *All fees are due at the time of registration.* Camp placement is not confirmed until fees have been paid. Fee includes the listed program, craft materials, and snacks.

#### • How will I know my child is registered for the camp?

Confirmations will be sent to your email, please legibly print your email and check spam/junk folders if you do not receive a confirmation.

#### • Can an adult or guardian stay with child during the camp?

NO adults, parents, or guardians are allowed to stay during camp with the exception of the 3-5 year old camps. The VCCD offers different program opportunities for families; Summer Camp programs are strictly for children.

#### Are VCCD camp counselors CPR/First Aid/AED Trained?

Yes, VCCD camp counselors are trained. Camps will have a 10:1 campers to staff/volunteer ratio.

#### • Is the VCCD flexible with children attending camps outside their age range?
